New Hand Sanitisers


Please use the new wall mounted hand sanitisers located in: the building entrance of building, downstairs and upstairs corridors and café area. Ensure hands are



washed frequently. Staff will be cleaning all contact areas more frequently. Paper roll and spray will be left out in each room for users to clean the furniture they are using. After use staff will also clean down tables and chairs ready for the next hirer to use.

Social Distancing
